

## NEW ELECTORAL ROLL FOR 2019

Out with the old and in with the new.

This year we have to do a complete revision of the electoral roll.

To be eligible you have to be 16 or over, baptized and be either

- a) a member of the Church of England and resident in the parish (if not living in the parish you need to have attended regularly for 6 months), or
- b) a member of another Church which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also declare yourself to be a member of the C. of E and have attended regularly for 6 months.

The electoral roll shows how many people feel that St. Luke's is **their** church family.

It doesn't commit you to anything at all, but it does give you the right

- to stand for the P.C.C.
- be a sides person
- to be a warden

Our Annual Meeting this year is on April 11<sup>th</sup> and I will be have forms available for your applications later this month. This may seem a little early but there will be 2 weeks to get your applications in, 2 weeks for me to list your applications and then the new list has to be displayed in church for 2 weeks before the meeting.
